## ***What is ISO?***

***(The Geneva based International Organization for Standardization)***

***ISO is a worldwide federation that's published a set of internationally recognized guidelines to which businesses subscribe and adhere to enhance their ability to do business.***

***To become ISO certified, a business must first develop a quality management system that is compliant to the ISO Standard for Quality Management Systems Requirements. Then, they must arrange for a Certifying Body, in our case Underwriter Laboratories, to perform a Registration Assessment.***

***A trained Auditor or Audit Team will come into our facility and examine how we do business; they will look at how things are documented, the commitment of Management, how we focus on Customer Requirements, how Production is planned and controlled, how we measure things and how we measure the things we use to measure things.  
If everything measures up, we are awarded ISO certification.***

***ICTC first earned ISO 9002:1994 certification in 1996.  
Then ISO underwent an overhaul and developed the ISO 9001:2000 standard for quality management systems to which ICTC, again, earned certification.***

***As of our renewal assessment of 2010, ICTC successfully made the transition to the newest version of the Standard, ISO 9001:2008, by going through the registration/certification process described above.***
